

# 2008 MONEY TEAM RULES

## GENERAL RULES

1. All Open Money Team Managers/Owners Must submit to the Open Money Team Representative a New Team Roster at least 7 days prior to the event in which the team will be competing.  
Example: If you are going to compete at an event on Saturday the 12th the roster must be received by Friday the 4th at midnight.
2. Submitted with the Original team roster there must be a Signed Commitment Form From Every Rider Listed on the Team Roster.  
NOTE: This Form MUST BE SIGNED by the rider, parent (if under 18 years of age) and the team manager. When changing the Roster the new commitment forms are all that must be sent. The other forms are already on file.
3. If there is no signed commitment form submitted for a rider on a roster, that rider can not be used on a team sheet and will not be published in the team packet.
4. All Open Money Team rosters submitted to the Open Money Team Representative will be printed and given out at each qualifier weekend to each team competing in there New/Updated "Team Packet".
5. Riders who are not and have not been on a current season's (Florida Five Star and Florida State Season are two different seasons) roster are eligible to be added to a team seven (7) days prior to the race in which he/she will be competing.
6. A rider may be on only one (1) roster in only one (1) team category at any time.
7. If a rider (on a current money team roster) decides to change teams he/she may not be added to another money team roster after November 1st of the 5-Star season and April 1st of the state season. The Open Money Team Representative must be notified in writing prior to 12:00 midnight of the dates listed above. The above-mentioned notification must be signed by the rider (and parent of the rider if the rider is under 18) listed on the Team Commitment Form.  
  
The notification in this case must be accompanied by a commitment form and a new team roster for the said rider to be eligible to race for the new team. This action will also require the 7-day prior notification as previously described.
8. If a team member is found to be illegal the entire team sheet may be disqualified for the race in which the illegal team member is entered.

**9. Any rider that has been reclassified back in proficiency by the NBL after May 5th 2006, that rider (he/she) will not be eligible to be utilized on an Open Money Team Sheet in any class. The rider (he/she) will be able once again to be utilized on the team sheet when the said rider has returned to his/her original proficiency.**

## COMPOSITION, ENTERING, AND SCORING

1. Team Managers may enter one (1) or two (2) team sheets at all state qualifiers.
2. All Team sheets must be signed by the Team Manager or designated agent. Designated agent = A person who will be in charge of handling the team sheets / entry forms for the day's event. The Manager must (prior to that event) give Written or verbal authority for this individual to handle the daily duties for said event. This must be done directly to the Open Money Team Representative.
3. Team sheets with their totals. Must be turned in at the team tent within fifteen (15) minutes after the completion of the last main of the day. If you have entered two team sheets both sheets should be turned in and after validation of the scores. Only the team sheet with the highest total will be used for that day's awards.
4. All team sheets and entry fees must be submitted, to the Open Money Team Representative, prior to the drop of the gate for the first Moto of the day.
5. Team entry sheets may not have less than 3 riders to be valid.
6. Team entry sheets may use up to five (5) riders and the lowest score on that sheet will be dropped using the best 4 scores for the total on that sheet for the day.
7. Team sheets that use five (5) riders must utilize at least one female rider on each sheet submitted with five (5) riders.
8. Open Money Teams may utilize the following riders; Elite Men, Experts, Two (2) Cruiser, two (2) Females, Two (2) Novices, and one (1) open.
9. Any class a female rider participates in (cruiser, open, novice, and female) constitutes a female class to be used, as the 5th rider on a team sheet, but still must follow the criteria set forth in item 8 above.
10. Only registered riders who are at the event may be used on team sheets.
11. A rider may not be used twice on the same team sheet.
12. A rider may not be used on two different team sheets in the same class.
13. Rainouts. In the event that there is a rainout for one day of the qualifier weekend the following rule will apply.
14. For a team to receive credit for both days of competition the team must have been entered for both days and all riders on the team sheets must be registered for both days. (See Awards for Moines and points).
15. All Team riders must wear jerseys with the rostered team name being the predominant name on the jersey.

## POINTS

Full main points will be given to riders who have 4 or more riders in their class for that day's event. Note: A combined class is that rider's class for that day's event.

1. Classes with three (3) or less riders will receive half main points for the day. This will be according to the overall finish for the day.

2. Bonus points: Will be awarded to each rider based on the number of riders he/she has in his or her class. See below.

# of Riders	Bonus Points
1 - 6	4
7 - 12	8
13 - 24	12
25 - 49	16
50 - XX	20

3. Team points at the Championship Event will be double points.

4. Points earned at each qualifier will go toward the Open Money Teams year-end award.

5. The best 6 scores out of the 10 State Qualifier races will be counted for the year-end awards plus the State Championship.

## TIE BREAKERS

1. In the event of a tie between teams, the tie will be broken according to the following format.

1st tie breaker = most first place finishes in the mains.

2nd tie breaker = most second-eighth place finishes in the mains.

3rd tie breaker = most total bonus points

4th tie breaker = highest classification of rider on the four member scoring team. AA/A Pro, Expert (by age) oldest to youngest, Female oldest to youngest, Cruisers oldest to youngest, open class oldest to youngest, Novice oldest to youngest.

2. A tie in the season points will be broken according to how the teams placed at the State Championship race. The team that finishes higher at the Championship race will be awarded the higher position in the season points.

## ENTRY FEE

1. Team Entry fee's will be \$20.00 per team sheet per day.

2. Every legally entered Open Money Team is eligible for the prizes and awards of the day.

3. A team may choose to enter multiple team sheets for that day's event (maximum of 2 team sheets). The entry fee for every team sheet will be added to the total money for that day's purse. The total number of teams that will be used to divide the purse for that day's event will be number of teams entered with a different rostered name.

4. Teams will be placed according to their scores from highest to lowest.

5. Payout of the event purse will be the approved payout schedule.

## TEAM AWARDS DAILY

1. The Open Money Team purse per day's event will be as follows:

## YEAR-END AWARDS

1. The best 5 scores out of the 8 State Qualifier races will be counted for the year-end awards plus the State Championship

Year-end awards to be discussed at the first State qualifier at the open money team meeting at 9:00 AM.
